To meet the needs of its veterinary clients, Alcyon, a company specialized in the distribution of medicines, food, equipment, and veterinary services, relies on two platforms located in Nice and Montpellier, as well as four ANSES-accredited warehouses in Arras, Landerneau, Lyon, and Pau.

These facilities enable the reception, storage, and preparation of a catalog of 18,000 products, ensuring fast shipping and consistent service quality across the entire country.

SAVOYE SUPPORTS ALCYON IN HARMONISING AND DEVELOPING ITS LOGISTICS PROCESSES

As part of its logistics operations, Alcyon uses the Logys solution developed by SAVOYE, a warehouse management and traceability system. This software has been gradually deployed across all of the company's logistics sites.

Each site had initially customized the solution to meet its own specific needs. A harmonization initiative was then launched to standardize processes nationwide, based on a common and centralized system.

Thanks to a multi-site architecture integrated into a central server, the company was able to strengthen team coordination, standardize its procedures, and rely on performance indicators to manage its supply chain more effectively.

The collaboration between Alcyon and its software provider also continued with the integration of additional modules, notably for the management of hazardous materials and transport labeling.
